

Exterior Lighting Standards:

The following is paraphrased from Teton County Subdivision Ordinance 8-4-5-G Residential Lights:

1. Exterior lighting brighter than 60 watt incandescent (75 watt controlled by motion detector) shall be shielded so that no light is projected above the horizontal and the lamp shall be diffused or shielded so that it cannot be seen from roadways, public areas, or any other property.
2. Floodlights are discouraged but are permitted if they are pointed in a downward direction (within 30 degrees of vertical) and they do not cause glare or light to shine on adjacent property or rights-of-way.
